



# Cheyenne Regional Airport

## Airport Ramp Access Terms of Application

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1. Applicant shall be subject to all applicable provisions of Transportation Security Administration (TSA) Regulations 49CFR Part 1542 and 1544, as amended.
2. Applicant has read and agrees to all provisions set forth in the Cheyenne Regional Airport AOA Acknowledgement Form. Additionally, applicant agrees to abide by all rules and regulations included within the Cheyenne Regional Airport Drivers' Training Program.
3. Applicant agrees to immediately report the loss or theft of any Airport Operators Permit (AOP) or Vehicle Permit to the Airport Office. Additionally, applicant agrees to notify the Airport Office if it is believed that the privacy of their gate access code has been compromised.
4. Applicant agrees to present Airport issued AOP to any official, Law Enforcement Officer, Airport representative or any other person possessing a valid AOP, upon request.
5. Applicant agrees to adhere to the following rules when operating a vehicle on the Airport Ramp:
  - a. Vehicles must yield to all aircraft, pedestrians and emergency vehicles.
  - b. All traffic control signage and devices shall be observed.
  - c. Any direction or guidance given to vehicular operators or pedestrian traffic by Airport Administration or FBO employees (on their ramp) will be strictly followed. Such direction could include restriction to areas for which the operator possesses a valid permit.
  - d. Vehicles and pedestrians are not permitted on any taxiway or runway ("movement area") at anytime unless a valid AOP with a movement area endorsement is possessed.
6. Applicant acknowledges and agrees that Airport Ramp access privileges may be revoked at any time without notice in event of the following:
  - a. Violation of any of these Terms of Application;
  - b. Violation of any local, state or federal ordinance, rule or regulation;
  - c. Termination of the permitholder's lease, operating agreement, employment, or other need to access the Airport Ramp;
  - d. If the Airport is directed by any local, state or federal authority to terminate vehicular access to the Airport Ramp.
7. Applicant agrees to maintain automobile liability insurance on vehicles operating on the Airport Ramp in an amount not less than the minimum limits required by the State of Wyoming. Evidence of such coverage shall be provided to the Airport immediately upon request.

By submitting this application and in consideration of the granting of vehicular access privileges to the Airport Ramp, I the undersigned applicant acknowledge that I have read, understand and agree to be bound by the aforementioned Terms of Application.
